- 2. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

 - We are asking trivia master if he wants to try out the microphone
 - The number of people attending may need to be capped because fewer people can fit in the room than with stressbusters since people will be sitting at tables
 - Back up plan to move to the pit if there are a lot of people
 - Candy grams were good
 - d. UBC/SFU Social Event
